GREAT IS YOUR FAITH!

Remember last week when we heard the Gospel story of Jesus walking on the water? Remember what happened to Peter? Peter dared to walk on the water himself, but when the wind rose and the storm strengthened, he panicked and called out to Jesus to save him. Remember what Jesus said to him? He reproved Peter, his closest disciple, saying, "O you of little faith" (Matthew 14:31). On the other hand, today we hear Jesus tell a Canaanite woman - a pagan woman in pagan territory - who acknowledges him as "Son of David," addresses him as "Lord" three times, and persistently pleads with him to heal her daughter, "O woman, great is your faith!" (Matthew 15:28). Significantly, Jesus does this in front of his disciples, giving this Gentile woman the opportunity to teach the disciples true faith. She recognizes God's merciful grace flowing through Jesus and realizes that there is so much of it that even "the scraps" can overflow all the way to her daughter, a nonbeliever who is not even present. Jesus saves both Peter and the woman's daughter, but in remarking upon her faith he shows his disciples the importance of persevering in faith, even when the Lord does not appear to be answering.

What have you been praying for persistently? How can you emulate the Canaanite woman in asking for God's help?

¡QUE GRANDE ES TU FE!

¿Recuerdas la semana pasada, cuando escuchamos el relato evangélico de Jesús caminando sobre las aguas? ¿Recuerdas lo que le sucedió a Pedro? Pedro se atrevió a caminar él mismo sobre el agua, pero cuando se levantó el viento y arreció la tormenta, sintió pánico y clamó a Jesús para que lo salvara. ¿Recuerdas lo que Jesús le dijo? Reprendió a Pedro, su discípulo más cercano, diciéndole: "¡Hombre de poca fe!" (Mateo 14:31). En cambio, hoy escuchamos a Jesús decirle a una mujer cananea —una mujer pagana en territorio pagano— que lo reconoce como "Hijo de David", se dirige a él tres veces como "Señor" y le suplica con insistencia que cure a su hija: "¡Mujer, qué grande es tu fe!" (Mateo 15:28). Es significativo que Jesús haga esto delante de sus discípulos, brindando a esta mujer gentil la oportunidad de enseñarles lo que es la verdadera fe. Ella reconoce la gracia misericordiosa de Dios que fluye a través de Jesús y comprende que es tan abundante que incluso "las migajas" pueden llegar hasta su hija, una no creyente que ni siquiera está presente. Jesús salva tanto a Pedro como a la hija de la mujer, pero al destacar la fe de ella, muestra a sus discípulos la importancia de perseverar en la fe, incluso cuando parece que el Señor no responde.

¿Por qué cosas has estado orando con perseverancia? ¿Cómo puedes imitar a la mujer cananea al pedir la ayuda de Dios?

WELCOME TO ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI, FATHER IGNACIO!

Please join us in extending a warm St. Francis welcome to Father Ignacio Cogollodo, who joins our parish community as our new parochial vicar.

Father Ignacio was born on October 14, 1986, in Davao City, Philippines, and is the youngest of eight children. Named after his father, Ignacio, he was baptized as an infant and has been Catholic his entire life. His vocation began in 2008 when a visit to the Vocationist Seminary in Davao City sparked his interest in the priesthood. Inspired by the seminary's strong sense of community—and even its basketball games—he answered God's call and entered formation.

He completed his undergraduate studies in Philosophy in the Philippines and earned his graduate degree in Theology at Immaculate Conception Seminary in Newark, New Jersey. Father Ignacio was ordained a deacon on November 3, 2019, at St. Cecelia Church in Iselin, New Jersey, and was ordained to the priesthood on October 17, 2020, in the Philippines, on the Feast of St. Ignatius of Antioch.

During his priesthood, Father Ignacio has served at St. James Church in Woodbridge, New Jersey; St. Nicholas Church in Palisades Park, New Jersey; and most recently as administrator of the Shrine Church of Our Lady of Solace in Brooklyn, New York. St. Francis of Assisi is his fourth parish assignment.

Father Ignacio speaks English and Filipino and recently spent five months in Colombia studying Spanish. He hopes to continue improving his Spanish with the help of our parishioners.

When asked about his first impression of St. Francis of Assisi, Father Ignacio shared, "It is a vibrant parish, and I hope it continues to be so." He is especially looking forward to bringing himself and our parish community closer to Jesus through his ministry.

In his free time, Father Ignacio enjoys watching movies, listening to music, and playing basketball and badminton. While he says he doesn't have a favorite food, he admits he is a bit selective when it comes to vegetables!

We are blessed to welcome Father Ignacio to our parish family. Please keep him in your prayers as he begins this new chapter of ministry at St. Francis of Assisi, and be sure to introduce yourself and offer him a warm welcome when you see him around campus.

BIENVENIDO A SAN FRANCISCO, PADRE IGNACIO!

Por favor, acompáñennos a dar una cálida bienvenida al estilo de San Francisco al Padre Ignacio Cogollodo, quien se une a nuestra comunidad parroquial como nuestro nuevo vicario parroquial.

El Padre Ignacio nació el 14 de octubre de 1986 en la ciudad de Davao, Filipinas, y es el menor de ocho hermanos. Llamado igual que su padre, Ignacio, fue bautizado cuando era un bebé y ha sido católico toda su vida. Su vocación surgió en 2008, cuando una visita al Seminario de los Vocacionistas en la ciudad de Davao despertó su interés por el sacerdocio. Inspirado por el fuerte sentido de comunidad del seminario —e incluso por sus partidos de baloncesto—, respondió al llamado de Dios e inició su formación.

Cursó sus estudios universitarios de Filosofía en Filipinas y obtuvo su título de posgrado en Teología en el Seminario de la Inmaculada Concepción en Newark, Nueva Jersey. El Padre Ignacio fue ordenado diácono el 3 de noviembre de 2019 en la iglesia de Santa Cecilia en Iselin, Nueva Jersey, y recibió la ordenación sacerdotal el 17 de octubre de 2020 en Filipinas, en la fiesta de San Ignacio de Antioquía.

Durante su ministerio sacerdotal, el Padre Ignacio ha servido en la iglesia de Santiago (St. James) en Woodbridge, Nueva Jersey; en la iglesia de San Nicolás en Palisades Park, Nueva Jersey; y, más recientemente, como administrador del Santuario de Nuestra Señora del Consuelo (Our Lady of Solace) en Brooklyn, Nueva York. San Francisco de Asís es su cuarta asignación parroquial.

El Padre Ignacio habla inglés y filipino, y recientemente pasó cinco meses en Colombia estudiando español. Espera seguir mejorando su español con la ayuda de nuestros feligreses.

Al preguntarle sobre su primera impresión de San Francisco de Asís, el Padre Ignacio comentó: "Es una parroquia llena de vida, y espero que siga siéndolo". Anhela especialmente acercarse él mismo, y acercar a nuestra comunidad parroquial, a Jesús a través de su ministerio.

En su tiempo libre, al Padre Ignacio le gusta ver películas, escuchar música y jugar al baloncesto y al bádminton. Aunque dice no tener una comida favorita, admite ser un poco selectivo a la hora de comer verduras!

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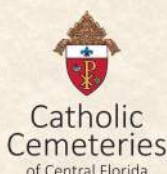
